June time came around and we organized a croquet tournament in our big, backyard in the morning.

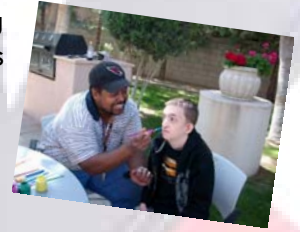

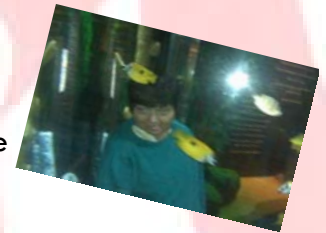


We are all very excited to have Julie wonderful donation we received. We are going to brighten our day with lovely
