

El Jardín de Marc Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

A ribbon cutting ceremony was held on May 17 at El Jardín de Marc, five triplexes with a total of 15 apartments for people with special needs (disabilities), Marc Center employees and people with housing choice vouchers (Section 8). When these triplexes were acquired in December 2008, they consisted of a set of buildings with kicked-in doors, broken windows, loose wires, overgrown weeds, strewn trash and a haven for wildlife. Now, with renovations completed, we see immaculate homes for adults and families. As Randy Gray, Marc's President & CEO stated during his speech, "...our properties must be the premier home or apartment complex in the neighborhood, both on the interior and the exterior."
